The Anthropology Library within the Centre for Anthropology at the British Museum is effectively the UK's national anthropology library. Its holdings comprise over 120,000 books and pamphlets and 4,000 journal titles, of which 1,500 are current. Many of the books and journals are donated to the Library by the RAI. The Library is located close to the North Entrance of the British Museum in central London, and is open to the public between 10.00 AM and 4.45 PM, and Thursdays between 12.00 PM and 7.00 PM. 
The AIO is a comprehensive, user-friendly online bibliography of journals held in the Centre for Anthropology Library at the British Museum.
